- Delay in approvals from MoD due to incomplete or improper documentation and MoD seeking documents through multiple iterations
- Lack of all the information necessary to comply with offset regulations
- Documents that may be required later not properly maintained by IOPs/OEMs

### Typical issues faced by IOPs:

- Lack of complete knowledge about the set of documents and prescribed formats to be forwarded to OEMs
- Ineffective management of documents as per requirements of the offset guidelines
